

NSW school libraries share: Library staff qualifications

In the 2021 Australian School Library Survey, we asked participants about the qualifications held by staff in their school library.

21% of respondents from New South Wales reported that no staff in their library had school library related qualifications, 13% reported that they had more than one qualified staff member in the library, and 9% reported that they have a library member currently studying.

The percentage of schools that reported at least one person in their library with a specific qualification is shared below.
