

QLD school libraries share: Library staff qualifications

In the 2021 Australian School Library Survey, we asked participants about the qualifications held by staff in their school library.

31% of respondents from Queensland reported that no staff in their library had school library related qualifications 21% reported that they had more than 1 qualified staff member in the library, and 1% reported that they have a library member currently studying.
